THE LIVERPOOL LOCAL PLAN – PUBLICATION (REGULATION 19)

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

The Council invites you to submit representations on the draft Liverpool Local Plan 2025-2043 (Regulation 19). This statement sets out the following information:

- When you can make representations
- The deadline for making representations
- How you can make representations
- How you can view key documents, including the draft Local Plan, the Sustainability Appraisal, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Habitats Regulations Assessment and the full supporting evidence base.

Representations may be made on any of these documents.

Plan Title

Regulation 19 Liverpool Local Plan 2025-2043.

Subject matter and geographical area covered

Liverpool City Council has prepared the Regulation 19 Liverpool Local Plan 2025-2043 for submission to the Secretary of State. The Local Plan includes the spatial vision, strategic objectives, growth and strategic spatial strategy, detailed policies and land allocations for the period up to 2043, a monitoring framework and a policies map. It covers the administrative area of Liverpool City Council.

Period for making representations

Representations are invited for a period of six weeks, between Monday 10 August 2026 and ending at **midnight** on Sunday 20 September 2026.

How to make representations and what happens to your representation

Representations at this stage should relate to whether the Plan is legally compliant and whether it is sound, as required by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and national planning policy.

The use of the Representation Form (accessed via the consultation platform or downloaded from the Council website), is strongly recommended as this will ensure your comments are related to matters relevant to the subsequent examination by a Planning Inspector.

Where requested, all named representatives will be notified of future stages. Please note that copies of all comments received will be made available for the public to view, and therefore, cannot be treated as confidential. While the Council will compile a statement of the responses to the Local Plan Submission Draft consultation, it will not respond to them. All comments received will be submitted to the Secretary of State and considered as part of a public examination by an independent Planning Inspector. Submitted comments are formal representations and as such respondents can request to be invited by the Inspector to participate at public hearing sessions during Examination.
